Lesson Plan For Teaching Bus Expectations

Plan to have a bus at your school on this teaching day. Children will have their backpacks with them.

1. Practice walking to the bus using line basics.
 - **From the room to the bus – reinforce hallway expectations.**
 - **Outside – practice walking in line.**
2. Show and discuss the bus rules while the children are seated on the bus. These 6 expectations came from transportation and posters will be on the buses.
3. Practice getting off the bus. Walk back to the room reinforcing line basics.
4. Reinforce proper behavior with positive comments.
5. Send home the parent piece, which is a die cut bus with bus rules and parent note.

School Bus Safety Rules



1. Stay out of the bus danger zone.

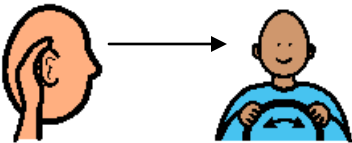


2. When riding the bus, remain seated at all times.

3. Keep hands, feet, and belongings to yourself.



4. Use quiet voices and be courteous.



5. Follow the driver's instructions.



6. Bring only school-approved items on the bus.



7. Be respectful of bus space and equipment.
