

NOTICE TO SCHOOL EMPLOYEES of the PULASKI COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

In accordance with EPA regulations, the Pulaski County School Facilities have been inspected for friable (easily crumbled) as well as non-friable (not easily crumbled) building materials which contain asbestos. Asbestos-containing materials are known to cause health problems when fibers are breathed or ingested.

Friable or Non-friable asbestos-containing building materials found within the Pulaski County School Facilities are typically present in the following materials:

Thermal System Insulation, older types of floor tile and floor tile mastic.

A record of the specific types of asbestos noted during the initial inspections and follow up inspections performed each 3 years are outlined in the school specific Asbestos Management Plan. A diagram of the locations of friable and non-friable asbestos-containing materials and a copy of relevant EPA regulations are available in the Principal's Office or Administrative Offices of each school for review by any employee of the Pulaski County Board of Education.
